MATTHEW 6 V 19 - 21

Read the following verses...

¹⁹ "Don't store treasures for yourselves here on earth. Moths and rust will destroy treasures here on earth. And thieves can break into your house and steal the things you have. ²⁰ So store your treasure in heaven. The treasures in heaven cannot be destroyed by moths or rust. And thieves cannot break in and steal that treasure.

What do these verses mean? If these verses had a title, what do you think it should be? Consider the difference between 'treasures on earth' and 'treasures in heaven'. How do we react when things break and get worn out?

Verse 21 says...

²¹ Your heart will be where your treasure is.

What do you think this means? These verses can be very challenging. Do you agree/disagree? Why?

How do the words 'distracted', 'divided' and 'devoted' link with Matthew 6 v 19-21?

Could you use these three words in a poster to help share Matthew 6 v 19-21 with someone else?
