LUKE 10 V 25-37

Discuss the story of the Good Samaritan. Can you draw a storyboard? What do we learn from this story? Who is our neighbour? How can we show kindness to others? Could you make up a modern day version of this story?



Why not, create a heart shaped 'love your neighbour' poster or make heart shaped biscuits. This is my favourite biscuit recipe!!

You will need...300g flour, 150g caster sugar, 250g soft butter, an egg yolk, 2tsp vanilla essence and ½ tsp salt

1. Beat the butter and sugar together in a bowl.
2. Add the vanilla essence and egg yolk and continue to beat. Add the flour and salt and mix it all together.
3. Use your hands to shape the mixture into a ball. Wrap it in cling film and pop in the fridge for half an hour.
4. Roll out the mixture until ½ cm thick, cut out hearts and put on a baking tray.
5. Put the biscuits in the oven (180°C) for 12 minutes. Then put them on a cooling rack.
