In a way that is beyond our experience, the church in the Two Thirds World is growing. About $1/3^{rd}$ of 'Crosslinks' workers are involved in training emerging


church leaders.






living faith in Jesus Christ. We hear from them regularly and this month we will be praying for them as we remember 'Crosslinks'

Who comes to Heaven?

Shortly before the start of the Second World War Benito Mussolini decreed that it was forbidden for Italians to emigrate to the USA.

At that time two Italians, born in Italy, who had been living for some time in the USA, were in Italy. One was a well-known banker who spoke English perfectly and who had first class connections. The other one had become a farmer in the USA. He only spoke a little bit of English and did not know much about the American way of life.

Both tried hard to get permission for a fast return to the USA. But only one was allowed to go. It was – against all expectations – the farmer. He was an American citizen. Because of this the decree from the dictator did not apply to him. The banker had remained Italian citizen. His protests, his wealth, his ability to speak English perfectly and his relations had no influence whatsoever.

Similarly, this applies to the question who will go to Heaven. You can lead an honest, apparently Christlike life, have excellent relations to believers and even know Biblical language perfectly. But all this does not give you any right to go to Heaven. Human beings become "Citizen" of heaven by being born again – turning to God and having complete Faith in our Saviour Jesus Christ.


